Summer Camp & Honduras Updates

Following a rousing send-off from Fayetteville, our campers arrived safe and sound Sunday afternoon at Camp Meribah in Centerville, TN! As of Monday morning Brad reported in that everyone was "up and at 'em" and ready for breakfast... and a full week of fun and activities! Keep our young people in your prayers this week as they are away. Friday is "Family Night" at camp and all parents are invited up to Meribah for dinner and the annual camp awards. Camp concludes Friday evening at 6pm and the bus should arrive back to Fayetteville around 8-8:30pm.

The Honduras team continues to report that things are going well with their trip. They were able to worship at *Iglesia de Cristo* in the *Valle de Angeles* on Sunday and conduct a free medical clinic for residents there following services. Already one house had been constructed and the construction crew is to begin a second one today (Monday). Ricky Pierce and the rest of the team will bring a report to the congregation on Sunday morning during worship. Keep them all in your prayers. They are due to arrive back in the states late Thursday evening (probably early Friday).
