It would have only been the 21st "perfect" game in all of Major League Baseball history... a feat indeed! The play in question occurred in the bottom of the ninth inning with two outs. Jason Donald hit a little grounder between first and second which was quickly fielded by first baseman, Miguel Cabera and thrown to Galarraga who was covering first. It was an easy play. Galarraga knew it. Donald knew it. And, later, even umpire Jim Joyce admitted that he had blown it. So, what did the pitcher do? Get in the umpire's face? Kick dirt on his shoes? Cuss him out? Appeal to the higher authorities? Nope... Galarraga just smiled and went back to the mound. After the game when Joyce had a choice to review the play, he searched out Galarraga personally and apologized. According to all reports, Galarraga accepted the apology saying, "Nobody's perfect." What a lesson in grace and class... from Major League Baseball of all places! So, Galarraga's pitching game won't go down in the record books as a "perfect" one... but I sure do appreciate his example! I sure am glad that I can point to him and that play as an example to my boys who could learn a little bit about sportsmanship. Thanks, Armando Galarraga, for your example of grace and class. And thanks, too, to Jim Joyce who was man enough to admit when he was wrong, even if he had to swallow his pride a little bit. I don't usually follow MJB much, but I'm a new fan of Galarraga!
