"A Word from Honduras"

Goal- to explore ways to embody the Great Commission either by supporting the work in Honduras or in our own neighborhood.

Read: Mark 16:15-16; James 1:27; Matthew 11:4-6

- Has anyone in this group been to Honduras on one of our mission brigades? How did your experience relate to what we heard this morning of this year's trip? Share some thoughts...
- Has anyone in our group been on any other type of mission trip outside the country? How did your experience relate?
- What about mission points inside the U.S.? What do we know of those experiences?
- Is there anywhere you would like to go as a short term missionary?
- Who can name the mission points that we support either fully or partially at Washington Street?
- How does the work in Honduras fit within God's greater work mentioned in these texts we've read?

Discuss:

- What did you find most interesting about the comments made this morning about our involvement in Honduras?
- What would you like to know more about?
- Do you feel like the congregation is under-informed, overly-informed or well-informed about our work there?
- How can EACH of us work to support our ministry to Honduras and other mission efforts even if we cannot go ourselves? Where to start?
- Housing, food, clothing, education and Biblical instruction can be provided for a child at *Jovenes en Camino* (the boys' home for orphaned or homeless children) for \$100 per month. Would your group or anyone in your group be interested in providing this for a child? (information has been provided to your group leader or you can contact Jim for more info)
- What can we do in our own neighborhood of Fayetteville to minister to people in need and/ or share the gospel?
